Moscow Mayor Pours E110 Million into Bulgarian Seaside Resort

Moscow Municipality is about to invest in construction of children's summer camps near the Bulgarian seaside resort of Kamchia. Over the three years to come, Yury Luzhkov's institution will pour 110 million euros into the resort as not long ago it purchased 40 hectares of land, intent on building an international summer complex for children. The project envisages construction of three camps, a cultural center as well as several concert and exhibition halls. There will also be a school where teaching will be in full accord with methods and syllabuses provided by the Russian educational system. Science and technology research labs, two swimming pools, a running track and an ice rink are but a few of the school's facilities, all of which will be designed after the latest fashion.

The complex will be open year round. In summers, it will be a place of rest for Russian pupils and university students, and in winters, sportsmen will come on training camps. It also emerged that the locally based Kamchia AD are planning to build hotels and villa complexes that will spread over 22 hectares soon. Moreover, certain international companies, according to unnamed sources, were keenly interested in investing into local family housing complexes construction.
