Presentation of Kamchia Children's Sanatorium and Recreational Complex Development Programme in Varna (Bulgaria)

September 17, 2008



On September 11 — 12 a delegation of the Russian capital headed by Lyudmila Shvetsova, First Deputy Mayor of Moscow in the Moscow Government, visited Varna and participated in the presentation of the Kamchia Children's Sanatorium and Recreational Complex Development Programme for 2007-2009.

The Kamchia Sanatorium and Recreational Complex is located on the Bulgarian Black Sea coast, 18 km off the city of Varna. The Kamchia project was launched on the initiative of the Moscow Government in 2003. The complex includes the Longoz Hotel, the Cristal Canteen and the Pirin Holiday Village. Over 10 thousand socially disadvantaged Moscow children, representatives of students' and public movements of the Russian capital have enjoyed Kamchia's services as of today.

The presentation was attended by representatives of state and local authorities, general public, construction and design organizations and mass media of Varna and Sofia. Speaking at the presentation, Lyudmila Shvetsova highlighted that the renovation and development of the Sanatorium and Recreational Complex will ensure its year-round operation enabling the complex to receive over 15 thousand young Muscovites every year. The plan includes the construction of two new buildings with the capacity of 600 people each; educational, diagnostic and treatment and balneological centres; an open field-and-track training area and a swimming pool; a summer theatre as well as some administrative buildings.

In course of their trip the Moscow guests met with the Mayor of Varna, Kiril Yordanov. Mrs. Shvetsova informed Mr. Yordanov about Kamchia development projects for the next forthcoming years and expressed hope for further fruitful cooperation. Moscow and Varna are looking forward to cooperation in the areas of education, culture and sports.
